Call to Order. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Commissioner Elwell who led the Pledge of Allegiance to our flag.

New Business. 1. Motion: Chris Johnson – Permanent Assignment to Captain. Commissioner Sitterley moved, and Commissioner Peden seconded, a motion to assign Chris Johnson to a permanent Shift Captain position effective October 1, 2019 with a six-month probationary period. As agreed in the contractual consolidation between North Highline Fire District and King County Fire District 2 and the Union, this promotion is being made from the North Highline Fire District Captain Promotional List that was in effect at the time the vacancy occurred. Motion carried, 3-0.

Good of the Order. Chief Marrs said there will be a badge pinning for Chris Johnson at one of the November board meetings. Chief Marrs said that on October 16, 2019, a 90 minute program will be presented by Code4NW, dealing with grief, healing, and prevention. Another similar presentation is being planned with the date to be announced. The Chief said he will be contacting the EAP administrators and it was suggested by Chair Elwell that he also contact the administrator of the Health Insurance Program of WFCA.

Adjournment. It was moved and seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried, 3-0. At 5:48 p.m., after the Board reviewed and approved any necessary papers and/or vouchers, the meeting was adjourned.
