Requirements and Minimum Qualifications

Minimum Qualifications:

20 years of age at time of application.

High School Diploma or GED.

Valid driver's license (must obtain Washington State Drivers License within 30 days of hire).

Must obtain EMT Certification within one year of employment.

Applicants must be of good moral character. The following indicate a lack of good moral character:

- Immoral or illegal conduct.
- Conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation.
- Intentional deception, fraud, attempted deception or fraud in any application, examination or other document.
- Evidence of financial irresponsibility.
- Conduct that is prejudicial towards others.
- Acts of conduct that would cause a reasonable person to have substantial doubts about the individual's honesty, fairness, respect for the right of others or for the laws of the State or Nation.
- Conduct that adversely reflects on the individual's fitness to perform as a firefighter.
- Conduct that would interfere with an individual's ability to be perceived as a credible witness in court.

THE APPLICATION

- Applications will be accepted at Headquarters Station beginning August 19, 2009 at 9 AM pst. Applications will be accepted from 9 AM pst until 3PM pst, Monday through Friday until the first 250 have been received or September 3, 2009 @ 3 PM pst whichever comes first.
- There will be a total of 250 applications accepted, no applications will be accepted by mail.
- One application per person (you can go to the end of the line and turn in another if 250 have not been accepted yet).
- \$30.00 application fee at time drop off.
- Only complete application packages will be accepted. A complete application package consists of:
 1. The completed application.
 2. 2-self addressed stamped envelopes.
 3. \$30.00 Cash, or **Cashiers** Check made out to King County Fire District #2.

THE WRITTEN TEST

If you successfully turned in an application you are automatically scheduled for your written examination

- The written test will be held at

- The test will be held September 16, 2009. The doors will open at 5:30 PM. Check in will be from 5:30 PM until 6:30 PM. Picture I.D. must be shown at the door.
- No admittance after 6:30.
- This test will be administered by an independent testing agency.
- The top 30 written scores and ties will proceed to the physical ability test.

THE PHYSICAL ABILITY TEST

- The physical ability test will be given on October 10th, 2009.
- Applicants will be notified by mail of their written score and if they are selected to advance to the physical ability test.
- Upon notification of advancement there will be a copy of the specifics for the physical agility process.

THE ORAL BOARD

- The top 30 candidates and ties that pass the ability test shall continue to the Oral Board.
- The Oral Board will be conducted by a combination of Labor and Management.
- The Oral Board shall consist of pre-determined questions and follow-up conversation. This should take between 20 and 30 minutes.

THE CHIEF'S INTERVIEW

- The top 20 candidates shall continue to the Chief's interview.

SCORING

WRITTEN TEST	60%
PHYSICAL AGILITY	PASS/FAIL
ORAL BOARD	20%
CHIEF'S INTERVIEW	20%

- There will be a Pass/Fail swim test given prior to employment.

Veteran's preference points shall be provided as set forth in the Washington State R.C.W.'s.

An additional 5 percentage points will be awarded to the written score of all current K.C.F.D. #2 volunteers with a minimum 1-year continuous service with the Department at time of application.
